**PROJECT TITLE: Construct Stingers Park for NBVC PH13-824 @ Port Hueneme NCG1 APF & NRSW NAF, Executed by Seabee Construction**

**Scope:** Convert Stingers Softball Field to a Family Picnic Grounds PH5326. Construct a pavilion (40' octagon) on concrete slab with concrete stoop, electrical power for refrigeration and additional receptacles for other electrical appliances, electrical circuits with GFCI for exterior electrical feed, plumbing for sinks and drains, concrete access driveway for delivery and maintenance to pavilion and a 14'x 20' stage, approximately (28) picnic benches on 4"x 10' 10' square concrete slab, installation of barbecue grills throughout, concrete stage for command and other social functions; sand volleyball court, concrete surface basketball court with backboards and rims, children playground with fall protection and youth size play equipment, install sod throughout, sidewalks, landscaping, irrigation and drainage to meet new layout. Plant trees for picnic grounds. Construct a trash enclosure. Create pathways from parking area to picnic grounds. Modify & repair fencing to accommodate new flow of traffic for picnic grounds. Parking area to east of Stingers Grounds was contracted for paving and striping. Project was phased to accommodate Seabee Homeport Construction.
